DSA Domaine Saint Amand Bordeaux rosé 2021

Domaine de Saint Amand is situated in the village of Cambes on the banks of the Garonne river. By the remarkable terroir of its vineyard slopes, and the domain's small size, it stands apart from other properties. The 3.2 hectares of vines allow a very attentive approach to the cultivation of the vines as well as very careful ageing. Sarah Simon took over the domain in 2018. She is an enthusiastic young winegrower, motivated by the passionate desire to produce quality wines that are both authentic and well-balanced. The estate is currently in conversion to organic viticulture.

HARVEST AND VINIFICATION:

- Cool early-morning picking by hands in protective trays
- · Immediately pressing
- · Cold stabilization (10°C) on the fine lees further to settling
- · Vat fermentation

AGEING: 50% stainless steel vats. Bottled at the domain.

TASTING NOTES: Resolutely modern wine that is lively, elegant, and full of fruit. It is born of our mastery of traditional savoir faire: harvested by hand, pressed immediately, and vinified at low

temperature.

The robe is a slightly powdery pale pink; aromas include white peach, water-melon, and even toffee... a perfectly refreshing wine
