

DSA DU DOMAINE DE SAINT - AMAND

CADILLAC CÔTES DE BORDEAUX 2019

Domaine de Saint Amand is situated in the village of Cambes on the banks of the Garonne river. By the remarkable terroir of its vineyard slopes, and the domain's small size, it stands apart from other properties. The 3.2 hectares of vines allow a very attentive approach to the cultivation of the vines as well as very careful ageing. Sarah Simon took over the domain in 2018. She is an enthusiastic young winegrower, motivated by the passionate desire to produce quality wines that are both authentic and well-balanced. The estate is currently in conversion to organic viticulture.

VINIFICATION:

- Pre-fermentation and alcoholic fermentation under organic protection (no SO2) in temperature – controlled vats
- Malolactic fermentation in vats

AGEING: 100% stainless steel vats

TASTING NOTES: a deep black-cherry to ruby-red robe. The bouquet is deliciously tactile, with magnificent notes of blackcurrant and blackberry. On the palate the wine is dense and very smooth, perfectly enhanced by the sturdy tannins.
