



Domaine de Saint-Amand

Cadillac Côtes de Bordeaux 2021

Domaine de Saint-Amand is situated in the village of Cambes on the banks of the Garonne river. By the remarkable terroir of its vineyard slopes, and the domain's small size, it stands apart from other properties.

The 3.2 hectares of vines allow a very attentive approach to the cultivation of the vines as well as very careful ageing.

Sarah Simon took over the domain in 2018. She is an enthusiastic winegrower, motivated by the passionate desire to produce quality wines that are both authentic and well-balanced.

The estate has been certified organic since 2024.

TASTING NOTES :

A wine that embodies the distinctive character of Cadillac Côtes de Bordeaux red "finesse". Domaine de Saint Amand red is seductive and refined, with aromas of red fruits and spices.

The nose is incredibly tactile and greedy, with beautiful notes of blackcurrant and blackberry. Wine with a dense and unctuous mouth, marked out by fleshy tannins.
