Domaine de Saint-Amand is situated in the village of Cambes on the banks of the Garonne river. By the remarkable terroir of its vineyard slopes, and the domain's small size, it stands apart from other properties. The 3.2 hectares of vines allow a very attentive approach to the cultivation of the vines as well as very careful ageing.

Sarah Simon took over the domain in 2018. She is an enthusiastic young winegrower, motivated by the passionate desire to produce quality wines that are both authentic and well-balanced.

L'Exception represents the full expression of the great quality of the terroir. Produced from rigorously selected plots in the vineyard, it assumes the modernity of its style and in the respect of the traditional savoir-faire of Bordeaux wines.

The estate is currently in conversion to organic viticulture and certified HVE3.
